3rd Annual Mini Golf Madness Creativity Challenge!**

THE CHALLENGE

Each team of four to six students will theme and decorate a fully constructed indoor mini golf hole, helping to create a free, family-friendly event for the community.

THE PRIZES

Three (3) \$200 Fan Favorite Awards will be awarded, one each for PreK – 8 voters, High School voters, and Adult voters. **Three (3) \$100 category awards** will be selected by judges for the Most Creative Use of Materials, Most Engaging, and Best Overall Theme Execution.

WHEN

Teams will gather at Manheim Township Middle School on **Friday, March 20 from 5-10 pm**. Food, drinks, & music will be provided as well as supplies and materials to help decorate your hole. The Mini Golf Madness event will be open to public on Saturday, March 21 from 10 am-2 pm.

ELIGIBILITY

Students from any school-sponsored club, team or graduation class that has an approved student activity fund or booster club are eligible to participate. All challenge team members must be associated with the group they are representing. Each club, team, or graduation class may only have one team entered in the Creativity Challenge. Student participants agree to return all required permission slips by the stated deadline and be present for the entire Creativity Challenge on Friday, March 20, 2026 from 5-10 pm at Manheim Township Middle School.

Other creative materials, including paper, paint, markers, scissors, posterboard, etc. will be provided at the Challenge. All theming must be non-permanent, so it does not damage the mini golf holes. Power tools and construction materials (wood, nails, saws, etc.) are not permitted.

The expectation is that team members will CREATE most decorations/props during the Challenge, not just bring items to set-up. This is a challenge of teamwork, resourcefulness, and creativity!
